• The Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Open University (BAOU) was established by the Act No.14 of 1994 passed by the Gujarat State Legislature on 13th April, 1994, and assented to by the Governor of Gujarat on 27th July, 1994. The BAOU is the seventh Open University in the country in terms of their establishment. - The students are required to pass in all subjects.
- Eligibility for Admission:
- BLIS degree from any recognized university or any other qualifications considered equivalent to BLIS such as P.G. Diploma in Library Science/Librarianship from a recognized university.
- Professional work experience will carry some weightage in consideration of candidature for admission along with merit. 'Professional work experience' would however, mean doing professional work in recognized library or information unit
- Duration of Course: Min-Duration: 1 (Year) | Max-Duration: 4 (Year)
- Course fee: Male: Rs. 9030/- Female: Rs. 6321/-
- Centers: Recognized/Approved study centers of University
- SLM (Self learning Material): It will be provided to all Enrolled students in print format and also Soft copy is available on website.
- Counselling sessions: Saturday and Sunday at all approved centers.
- Students are required to submit assignments to the study center for the evaluation purpose. For their assignments submission, they must follow the deadlines assigned by the university.
- Yearly Exams: Jan/ July
- Mobility (Exit Point): Master of library and information science degree awarded only after completion of the one year successfully and Internship of one month.
