Bharatiya Shikshan Mandal

Concept: Bharat, the pioneer of the earliest educational system of the world where such luminaries as Bharadwaja, Kashyap and Agatsya led the path; India, which was home to global universities like Takshashila and Nalanda, is today, even after decades of independence, suffering the crushing load of Macaulayan system of education that was conceived to keep her tightly bound in the shackles of mental slavery.

- 6. Sanskrit language is the perennial source of Indian culture. Therefore Sanskrit be introduced as an integral part of the education system.
- 7. Indian society to be propelled on the road to self–reliance, power and prosperity, *Swadeshi* approach be developed through the medium of education.
